Raster Image Processor Tech Tips

1. Increase memory - When processing the jobs you send to the RIP it use the memory for fast data storage. This is especially true if the TrapPro integrated trapping plugin is being used. Significant improvement can be achieved if the amount of memory is doubled or tripled. Printware offers memory upgrades for you rip an an affordable cost.

2. Keep your error log clean!

Sometimes when you launch the RIP software it may take several minutes to start up. This can often be caused by a buildup of errored files or a large log file. To improve the start up time you can manually

delete the errored files. These are normally located in the "Error" folder inside of your rips "SW" folder. The log file is a file called "logfile" also located in the "SW" folder. With the RIP software not running, rename this file to logfile.old or something similar. Restart the RIP and it will automatically re-create a new logfile.
