Section 179 Bonus depreciation reduces by 50% on January 1st , 2012

Ever wonder why so many companies purchase equipment at the end of the year? One reason is to make their business more profitable. The enacted Tax Relief Act amended the rules set forth in the Small Business Jobs Act to allow 100 percent bonus depreciation for qualifying new assets acquired and placed-in-service as of September 9, 2010 through 2011.

It must be purchased between September 9, 2010 and December 31, 2011. The original use of the asset generally must begin in your business by no later than December 31, 2011.

Assets Placed in Service in 2012

The 50 percent bonus depreciation rules return in 2012 for eligible assets placed in service during the year.

In Summary, the combined effect of the two laws is to allow:

- 100 percent bonus depreciation for qualifying assets placed in service September 9, 2010 and all of 2011
- 50 percent bonus depreciation for qualifying assets placed in service between January 1, 2012 and December 31, 2012
